# FARMS, ORCHARDS, PUMPKIN PATCHES, CORN MAZES, AND HAYRIDES

#### Hillcrest Orchards - Amherst, OH

- Dates: Open weekends in September and October for apple picking.
- Activities: Apple picking, pumpkin patch, wagon rides, and a corn maze.

#### Leeds Farm - Ostrander, OH

- Dates: Open weekends from September 16 to October 29, 2024
- Activities: Pumpkin picking, hayrides, zip lines, pedal carts, and a petting zoo.

#### Lehner's Pumpkin Farm - Radnor, OH

- Dates: Open weekends from September 14 to October 27, 2024
- Activities: Hayrides, a corn maze, pumpkin picking, barrel train rides, and a fun zone with slides and bounce houses. They also have campfires, which provide a cozy setting for storytelling and marshmallow roasting.

#### Lynd Fruit Farm - Pataskala, OH

- Dates: Apple picking season typically runs from early September through mid-October (check website for specific variety availability).
- Activities: Apple picking, corn maze, market with fresh cider, and baked goods.

#### Maize Valley Farm - Hartville, OH

- Dates: September 14 to October 27, 2024
- Activities: A large corn maze, hayrides through the scenic countryside, pumpkin patch, and farm animal viewing. They also have a play area for children and seasonal treats like apple cider and homemade donuts.

#### The MAiZE at Little Darby Creek - Milford Center, OH

- Dates: September 21 to October 27, 2024
- Activities: A 9-acre corn maze, hayrides, farm animals, a pumpkin patch, and play areas. They offer both a daytime maze experience and a "Flashlight Nights"
- experience for extra adventure.

#### Malabar Farm State Park - Lucas, OH

- Activities: Known for its stunning fall scenery, Malabar Farm offers group
  campfires as part of their educational programs, or you can book a campsite with
  a fire pit. Families can take a hayride, tour the historical farm, and end the day
  with a cozy campfire.

#### Mapleside Farms - Brunswick, OH

- Dates: Weekends from September 21 to October 27, 2024
- Activities: Pumpkin Village with a massive corn maze, hayrides, apple cannon, bounce pillows, and scenic fall views. Each weekend features different themes like "Pumpkin Fest" or "Johnny Appleseed Festival."

#### Pigeon Roost Farm - Hebron, OH

- Dates: Open daily from September 16 to October 31, 2024
- Activities: Pumpkin picking, a corn maze, play areas, a farm animal petting area, and a giant gerbil wheel.


#### Simmons Farm - Bethel, OH

- Dates: Open daily from September 16 to October 31, 2024
- Activities: Hayrides, corn maze, apple picking, a pumpkin patch, and a kids' play area with a corn box and slides. Families can also enjoy seasonal treats like kettle corn and apple cider.

#### Young's Jersey Dairy - Yellow Springs, OH

- Dates: Open daily from September 21 to October 31,2024
- Activities: Corn maze, wagon rides, pumpkin picking, and a "Cowvin's Corny Maze" designed for fun and safe exploration. They also offer farm animal petting and delicious homemade ice cream.

### **Fall Festivals**

#### Circleville Pumpkin Show - Circleville, OH


- Dates: October 16 to October 19, 2024
- Activities: Parades, giant pumpkin weigh-ins, rides, games, food vendors, and live entertainment.

#### Apple Butter Festival - Grand Rapids, OH

• Dates: October 12 to October 13, 2024

• Activities: Apple butter making, craft vendors, historic demonstrations, and live music.







#### **State Parks and Nature Reserves**

#### Hocking Hills State Park - Logan, OH

- Activities: Hiking trails, scenic overlooks, waterfalls, and picnic areas. Fall foliage is best viewed from late September through mid-October.
- Peak Foliage Dates: Early to mid-October
- Activities: Famous for its dramatic cliffs, waterfalls, and dense forests, Hocking Hills
  offers some of Ohio's most picturesque fall foliage. Popular trails for leaf peeping
  include Old Man's Cave, Ash Cave, and Cedar Falls. Consider taking the "Grandma
  Gatewood Trail," which offers a mix of terrains and stunning views.

#### Camp Akita - Logan, OH

- Activities: Camp Akita provides a serene setting in the Hocking Hills area with opportunities for organized campfires. They offer guided programs where families can participate in activities like sing-alongs, storytelling, and making campfire treats.

#### Cuyahoga Valley National Park - Brecksville, OH

- Peak Foliage Dates: Early to mid-October
- Activities: This national park provides a great mix of accessible trails and scenic drives perfect for leaf peeping. Families can take the Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad for a leisurely ride through the fall landscape or hike the Ledges Trail for breathtaking panoramic views.
- Activities: Scenic train rides, hiking trails, Brandywine Falls, and wildlife watching. Fall colors peak in early to mid-October.

#### The Holden Arboretum - Kirtland, OH

- Peak Foliage Dates: Early to mid-October
- Activities: Offering over 3,500 acres of lush gardens, woodlands, and trails, The Holden Arboretum is a prime spot for fall color viewing. The "Murch Canopy Walk" and "Kalberer Emergent Tower" provide a bird's eye view of the changing leaves and are great for kids and families.

#### Shawnee State Park - Portsmouth, OH

- Peak Foliage Dates: Mid to late October
- Activities: Known as the "Little Smokies of Ohio," Shawnee State Park offers a stunning array of colors each fall. Families can enjoy driving the scenic Shawnee State Forest Loop or hiking the park's many trails that wind through vibrant woodlands.

#### Geneva State Park - Geneva-on-the-Lake, OH

- Peak Foliage Dates: Mid-October
- Activities: Situated along Lake Erie, Geneva State Park offers a unique blend of fall foliage with waterfront views. Take the paved bike trail for a relaxed leaf peeping experience or head out on the water with a kayak to see the fall colors from a different perspective.
- Activities: With campgrounds right by Lake Erie, families can enjoy both the beautiful fall foliage and the tranquility of lakeside campfires. Many sites come equipped with fire rings and grills, perfect for an evening under the stars.

#### Mohican State Park - Loudonville, OH

- Peak Foliage Dates: Mid to late October
- Activities: With its picturesque Clear Fork Gorge, Mohican State Park is a top spot for fall foliage viewing. The "Gorge Overlook" is particularly beautiful in autumn, and there are numerous trails suitable for families, such as the Lyons Falls Trail.
